Subject: Approval of Grant Award Renewal—Alameda County Social Services

Agency, Community Action to Reach Out to Infants Program, Chabot College

<u>Background</u>: Chabot College has received notification from the Alameda County Social Services Agency for the Community Action to Reach Out to Infants (CARI) Program, of its intent to renew a grant for the continuation of services.

Under the CARI Program, the College provides specialized, pre-designed training for potential Foster Parents, Kinship Caretakers and Respite Providers to care for children that enter Alameda County's Child Protective Services through drug exposure, HIV, neglect or abuse. This will be the eighth year the Alameda County Board of Supervisors has chosen to reconfirm its dedication to the ideals of service to the community through the maintenance of this partnership with the College.

The Alameda County Social Service Agency will recommend for approval, to the Alameda County Board of Supervisors, the preliminary grant renewal amount of \$36,000 for the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.

The Board of Trustees approved grant renewals on August 19, 2003 under item 4.2 for \$60,000, July 20, 2004 under item 4.2 for \$36,000, July 19, 2005 under item 4.4 for \$36,000, June 27, 2006 under item 4.3 for \$36,000, August 21, 2007 under item 4.2 for \$36,000.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approve the proposed grant award renewal from the Alameda County Social Services Agency, Community Action to Reach Out to Infants Program, Chabot College, in the amount of \$36,000 for the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the proposed award upon receipt of the documents and any future augmentations or amendments to the award on behalf of the District.
