Subject: Approval for Use of Off-Campus Facility, Las Positas College

Background: Las Positas College uses off-campus facilities to conduct various classes in support of its educational mission. Continuously since the 2004-2005 academic year, the College has successfully offered a Physical Education Rock Climbing class. From Fall 2004 through Spring 2006 the Sunrise Gym, Livermore, served as an off-campus facility; from Fall 2006 through Spring 2008 the Cornerstone Fellowship, Livermore, served as an off-campus facility. The College now seeks to enter into an agreement to use Rock Gym, Livermore Area Recreation and Park District, as an off-campus facility for offering the Physical Education Rock Climbing class during Fall 2008. The former Sunrise Gym and Rock Wall location has been renovated and is now owned and operated by the Livermore Area Recreation and Park District as the Valley Rock Gym.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approve the agreement with the Livermore Area Recreation and Park District for use of the Rock Gym, located at 2455 Railroad Avenue, Livermore, CA 94550. The facility is provided to the District for Fall Semester 2008 at no cost. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.
