Memorandum of Understanding Support for the Community College Component Of the

UC Science and Mathematics Initiative (CalTeach)

The University of California Office of the President via the CalTeach Initiative hereby agrees to provide financial assistance from its Noyce Foundation award to Chabot College and its students exploring teacher careers in science and mathematics.

The funding provided the participating community college is:

- \$2,500 for development of program courses and administration
- \$4,200 per semester to support six (6) or more community college students (\$500 to \$700) who are taking or will take a seminar type course (equivalent to the CalTeach 1 and 2 courses at a UC campus).

In addition, as required, from a separate fund source, support of \$300 for mentor teachers from K—12 schools who accommodate two program participants in their classroom for the semester.

The funding covers the period January 1, 2009 through June 30, 2009. During the duration of the project, the participating community college will provide pertinent data on the students' in-class progress and field experiences.
