Subject: Approval of Solicitation to Request for Qualification (RFQ) for a Public-Private Partnership Under California Government Code Section 5956 to Develop an Educational Hub in the City of Union City

Background: District staff will seek submission of statements of qualification from interested private sector investors to plan, design, construct, finance, maintain, market and manage an educational and office/retail construction project in the City of Union City. California Government Code Sections 5956 and following give local governmental agencies the authority and flexibility to utilize private investment capital to construct certain infrastructure projects.

The District, in concert with the City of Union City and its Redevelopment Agency, proposes to construct a three to eight story building sized between 60,000 to 245,000 square feet which will both meet the partners' needs and assure a return on investment. The building will provide operational space for the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District Educational Hub, general office/retail space for lease, parking, and, if economically feasible (optional), provision for the Alameda County library branch in Union City. The building would need to be sized to provide an income stream from leased office/retail space sufficient to encourage investment into this project. Upon expiration of the lease term, the District (CLPCCD) will assume ownership of the privately constructed project at no additional cost.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approve the Solicitation to Request for Qualification (RFQ) for a Public-Private Partnership under California Government Code Sections 5956 and following to develop an educational hub in the City of Union City. Funding Source: Private Sector Investment Capital.
