<u>Background</u>: Chabot College has received notification from the California School-Age Consortium (CalSAC) of their eligibility to receive AB212 one time grant funding for the Alameda County Professional Development and Retention Project (PDRP).

AB212 allocates funding to state subsidized Title 5 childcare programs serving children ages 0-12 in Alameda County to implement professional development training plans for their staff. This year the PDRP serves both early childhood and school-age staff. AB212 is aimed at building a skilled and stable workforce to provide high quality child care and development services and its intention is to increase employee retention in state-subsidized child care centers.

The grant award is in the amount of \$12,000 for the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: That the Board of Trustees approve the grant award from the School-Age Consortium, AB212 Funding, Chabot College, in the amount of \$12,000, for the period July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the award document and any future augmentations or amendments on behalf of the District.
