Subject: Approval of Award of Bid No. 10-01, Cisco Switches, Chabot College and Las

Positas College

<u>Background</u>: Staff conducted a competitive public bidding process for new Cisco Switches for Chabot College and Las-Positas College, Bid No. 10-01. The District issued its standard specification for the Cisco brand network switches to match the standardized equipment already in place at the colleges and District. This new equipment will be used in new building construction and renovations at both colleges. The bid was advertised and twenty-four (24) bidders were contacted directly. Bids from four (4) bidders were submitted as below. Bid amounts include sales tax.

AMS. Net, Livermore, CA	\$ 346,034.79
IT Solutions, Modesto, CA	\$ 381,458.14
Jeskell, Sunnyvale, CA	\$ 387,723.42
UTDI, San Francisco, CA	\$ 405,477.66

All bids were evaluated by a committee of ITS staff from the District Office, led by Jeannine Methe, the District's Chief Technology Officer. The committee's recommendation was reviewed by Business Services staff and the evaluation concluded with the recommendation to award the bid to AMS.Net as the lowest responsible and responsive bidder.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: That the Board of Trustees award Bid No.10-01, for Cisco Switches to AMS.Net of Livermore, California, in the amount not to exceed \$346,035 including tax less a trade-in amount of \$16,033.14.
