Subject: Acceptance of Alameda County Workforce Investment Board (ACWIB)  
Career Transitional Services (CTS) Contract

Background: This initial contract is between Chabot College and the Alameda County Workforce Board (ACWIB), to provide Career Transitional Services to dislocated workers, bringing together the strengths of each organization to address the large influx of dislocated workers that has resulted from a prolonged economic recession. As a member of the ACWIB Rapid Response Team, Chabot counselors and staff will work with employers and businesses that have issued notices of impending layoffs to provide workers with employment services and training: core, intensive and training services. Chabot and the Eden Area One-Stop will share student/client data to identify dislocated workers, track services used, and measure progress towards meeting a combination of education and employment outcomes.

Funding for the project is for two years pending satisfactory performance on meeting program objectives. The total two-year contract amount is \$288,464 for the period of October 1, 2009 through June 30, 2011 to be awarded as follows:

FY 2009-10: \$144,232 for the period October 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010

FY 2010-11: \$144,232 for the period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees accept the ACWIB CTS Contract in the amount of \$144,232 for the period October 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the contract and any future augmentations or amendments to the contract on behalf of the District.
