<u>Background</u>: The invitation for bid was in accordance with state public bidding requirements. On July 22, 2010 a mandatory bid walk was held and attended by forty-five (45) interested parties. The public bid opening held at the District Office on August 17, 2010 resulted in the following base bid amounts:

An evaluation of the apparent lowest bidder, Alten Construction, removed their bid citing clerical error in their bid tabulation. The next three lowest bidders, JDS Builders, Angotti & Reilly, Jeff Luchetti Construction, also removed their bids citing clerical error in each of their bid tabulation. This results in a recommendation to award to CDX Builders, Inc. of San Francisco, CA as the lowest responsible and responsive bidder. The bid is within the construction budget of \$4,200,000.

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Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed Award of Bid No. 11-07, Industrial Technology Center Buildings 1400/1600, Chabot College, to CDX Builders, Inc. of San Francisco, CA, in an amount not to exceed \$4,165,800. It is further recommended that the Board authorizes the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the agreement and any future augmentations or amendments to the agreement on behalf of the District.
