Subject: Approval of National Institutes of Health Bridges to the Baccalaureate Program Subrecipient Commitment between the University of California, Berkeley and Chabot College

Background: Chabot College is making a subrecipient commitment with the University of California, Berkeley (UCB) for a total of \$30,808 per year for five years (\$154,040 total). The agreement is part of a National Institutes of Health (NIH) Bridges to the Baccalaureate Program that the UCB Transfer Alliance Project is leading in partnership with Chabot College and Merritt College. The program aims to substantially increase the transfer of students from underrepresented minority populations to biomedical and behavioral science degree programs at four-year institutions. Chabot College will target new and continuing students in key majors, specifically students in pre-nursing/allied health students and those in specific introductory major-specific courses. Grant funds pay for faculty and staff time to conduct program activities and achieve project outcomes.

Funding for the project is in the amount of \$30,808 per year for five years (\$154,040 total) for the period of April 1, 2011 through March 31, 2016.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed Acceptance of National Institutes of Health Bridges to the Baccalaureate Program Subrecipient Commitment between the University of California, Berkeley and Chabot College, in the amount of \$30,808 per year for five years (\$154,040 total) for the period April 1, 2011 through March 31, 2016. It is further recommended that the Board authorizes the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the Subrecipient Commitment Form and any future augmentations or amendments to the document on behalf of the District.
