Subject: Approval to Renew Standard Contract—County of Solano Standard Contract No. 00591-12, District-Economic Development

Background: Solano County’s Health and Social Services Department has contracted with Chabot-Las Positas Community College District’s Economic Development department to provide training to group home providers and foster family agencies serving Solano County since 2003-04. The County has requested that we continue to provide these training services for the 2011-12 fiscal year.

As with the previous contracts, we will be working closely with our partners, Seneca Center, Fred Finch Youth Center, and A Better Way, to deliver these trainings for their own organizations, as well as other community-based foster children caretakers. Additionally, the County’s Child Welfare Services incorporates training for their staff as part of this contract. The contract is funded through Title IV-E federal funds, and is in the amount of \$683,811.

The contract states that Solano County will pay the District up to \$683,811 for training services provided. This contract has a term of twelve months, July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. The contract requires an in-kind match, which is the District’s responsibility, which consists of the value of staffing, overhead, and facilities costs.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed standard contract renewal for the County of Solano Standard Contract No. 00591-12, District – Economic Development for the period July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012, in the amount of \$683,811. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the standard contract and any future augmentations or amendments on behalf of the District.
