Subject: Approval to Renew – Alameda County Social Services Agency – Master Contract No. 900035, District-Economic Development

Background: Alameda County Social Services Agency’s Children and Family Services has contracted with Chabot-Las Positas Community College District’s Economic Development department to provide training to those who work with out of home placement children of Alameda County since 2002. The County has requested that we provide training services for the 2011-12 fiscal year.

As with the previous contracts, the District will partner with community-based organizations, including A Better Way; Alternative Family Services; Children’s Hospital, Oakland; Family Paths; Fred Finch Youth Center; Lincoln Child Center; Seneca Center, St. Vincent’s School for Boys; and WestCoast Children’s Clinic to deliver these training services to people who work with foster and adoptive care children. Additionally, the Social Services Agency will utilize this resource for their employees’ training.

The contract states that Alameda County will pay the District up to \$4,298,075 for providing training services. This contract has a term of twelve months (July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012).

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed renewal of Alameda County Social Services Agency – Master Contract No. 900035, District-Economic Development for the period July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2012, in the amount of \$4,298,075. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the standard contract on behalf of the District.
