Subject: Approval of Memorandum of Understanding - City of Livermore for the Livermore Fourth of July Fireworks Celebration-Chabot-Las Positas Community College District, Las Positas College

Background: Las Positas College (LPC) has been approached to serve as the site for the 2013 Livermore Fourth of July Fireworks Celebration ("Livermore Fourth of July: An Old Fashioned Gathering"). The local groups involved in the planning - including the City of Livermore, Livermore Area Recreation and Park District (LARPD), and the Livermore Fireworks Committee have worked with the College on the event logistics.

For 27 years, the City of Livermore and LARPD put on the Fourth of July Celebration for community residents. The event was traditionally held in a local park and featured performances, activity booths, food and beverages, and a fireworks show. Due to unforeseeable budgetary issues, the Fourth of July fireworks celebrations ceased to be provided by the City in 2010. In 2012, Las Positas College served as host of the event. Restoration of the event at the College provided a tremendous benefit to the college with the local community.

This year's event is being staged at no cost to the college. Funding for the event will be driven by charging for parking and vendor fees. No alcohol will be allowed at the event.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed Memorandum of Understanding between Chabot-Las Positas Community College District (on behalf of Las Positas College) and the City of Livermore to hold the Livermore Fourth of July Fireworks Celebration on July 4, 2013. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the Memorandum of Understanding on behalf of the District.
