## BP 5410 ASSOCIATED STUDENTS ELECTIONS

Reference:
Education Code Section 76061

The Associated Students shall conduct annual elections to elect officers. The elections shall be conducted in accordance with procedures established by the Chancellor.

Any student elected as an officer in the Associated Students shall meet both of the following requirements:

- The student shall be enrolled in the District at the time of election and throughout his/her term of office, with a minimum of five semester units or the equivalent.
- The student shall meet and maintain the minimum standards of scholarship (see BP 4220 titled Standards of Scholarship and related administrative procedures).

## Legal Citation for BP 5410

## EDUCATION CODE SECTION 76061

76061. A student who is elected to serve as an officer in the student government of a community college shall meet both of the following requirements:
(a) The student shall be enrolled in the community college at the time of election, and throughout his or her term, with a minimum of five semester units, or its equivalent.
(b) The student shall meet and maintain the minimum standards of scholarship prescribed for community college students by the community college district.
