

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

**Marcus Foster Education Fund**

and

**Chabot College**

Regarding

**Grant Award to Participate in the College Bound Brotherhood 2.0 Program**

The following constitutes a memorandum of understanding the Marcus Foster Education Fund (MFEF) and Chabot College, regarding their respective responsibilities and shared commitment to the success of the College Bound Brotherhood 2.0 Program.

1. **Executive Summary of the Project.** The Marcus Foster Education Fund is a compassionate, collaborative organization seeking to help realize transformative educational equity for the Oakland community. We are a collection of servant leaders committed to innovation and accountability to improving the supports, rigor, expectations and outcomes of high academic achievement among the most disenfranchised students. Our work is achieved through serving as a backbone organization to critical initiatives targeting the Oakland schools and the Bay Area's education community. To that end, our goal is systemic collective impacts through convening, data collection, policy and advocacy, intervention design, implementation oversight and evaluation for student improvements at scale.

The overarching goal of the College Bound Brotherhood is to increase the college readiness, access, persistence, and completion of African American young men living in the San Francisco Bay Area. It is a collaborative effort spanning nine Bay Area counties with over 50 organizations involved in the growing network.

2. **Marcus Foster Education Fund (MFEF).** MFEF shall:
  - a) Award Chabot College's Striving Black Brothers Coalition (SBBC) a grant for \$10,000 for the period of January 15, 2014 – October 31, 2014;
  - b) Collaborate with Chabot SBBC students and staff to support CBB 2.0 activities; and
  - c) Provide assistance to identify additional resources for future efforts.
3. **Chabot College.** Chabot's Striving Black Brothers Coalition (SBBC) shall:
  - a) Use funds for the general operation of the Striving Black Brothers Coalition and the support of its students;
  - b) Attend all necessary and required grantee meetings;
  - c) Collaborate with MFEF to enrich the experience of SBBC students; and
  - d) Forego using any grant award funds for administrative or overhead costs.
4. **Payment for Services to be Performed.**

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**Grant Dln**

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The MFEF agrees to pay up to the total sum of \$10,000 to Chabot College for the services as described in the application submitted to the College Bound Brotherhood program. Upon receipt of a signed agreement, the MFEF will send payment for the full amount.
