## PRESENTATION: END OF YEAR RECOGNITIONS-STUDENT PROGRAMS, CHABOT COLLEGE

Dr. Susan Sperling and Chabot College Staff recognized outstanding programs and students for 2013-14, and acknowledged and celebrated those in attendance. The following Programs and outstanding students were recognized:

Striving Black Brothers Coalition. Dr. Jeanne Wilson and Mr. Art Barboza, Founder and Coordinator of the Program, reported that the coalition is a self-supporting program comprised of African American males attending Chabot College who strive for academic excellence through the use of mentors. The program assists the participants to excel academically, socially, culturally and professionally in college and the community. Students graduating from the Program, Mr. Amauri Collins McMurry and Mr. Tyri Watson, spoke to the benefits they have received from the Program.

<u>Distributive Education Clubs of America (DECA).</u> Ms. Katherine Pinkas, Instructor, introduced Mr. Alvaro Rojas-Hernandez, President and Mr. Andrew James Brown, Past President. A video was presented highlighting the Club's activities to date as well as the awards received at the annual National DECA Conference.

<u>Dental Hygiene.</u> Ms. Nancy Cheung, Program Director, introduced students Ms. Brooke Egan, Ms. Cailin Groenenberg, and Ms. Sarah Micek; and presented a video of the students' activities in the community this year. Ms. Cheung proudly reported that the program had 100% pass rate on the National and State Dental Hygiene Board Exams.

<u>Architecture.</u> Mr. Adrian Huang, Instructor, highlighted the Architecture Program, its activities, and the success of its students that transfer to four-year institutions.

<u>English as a Second Language (ESL).</u> Mr. Kent Uchiyama, Instructor, highlighted the success of the new ESL Writing Workshop, with one-on-one coaching. He introduced students and Writing Coaches Ms. Sarah Knight, and Ms. Emily Frone, who spoke of the benefits and importance of this program.

<u>Early Childhood Development.</u> Ms. Barbara Ogman, Instructor, and Ms. Darlene Johnson, Advisory Committee Member and graduate of Chabot College, highlighted the Early Childhood Development Program, which is a model of teacher training and education. They presented a PowerPoint Presentation of students speaking to the benefits of the program. Ms. Ogman expressed appreciation and recognized the importance of the Program's many partnerships. Ms. Johnson stressed the importance of the lab experience for the students.

<u>Athletics.</u> Mr. Jeff Drouin, former Interim Dean of Health, Kinesiology and Athletics, presented a PowerPoint Presentation highlighting the successes this year in Football, Men's Basketball, Women's Basketball, Men's Golf, and Baseball. He noted that this year's Athletics Program is dedicated to Mr. Gerald Shimada.

<u>Mathematics, Engineering, Science Achievement (MESA).</u> Ms. Donna Gibson, Instructor, presented a PowerPoint Presentation highlighting statistical data showing the successes of the Program and its students.

<u>Passion and Purpose.</u> Mr. Tom deWit, Instructor, reported that this Program is in its first semester at Chabot College. He reported that the Program was developed in response to students and communities that are struggling. The Program goal is to identify students' own passion and put that passion into practice in a purposeful way within their communities. Students shared their passion projects in areas such as: community garden, transportation initiative, door murals, room design and transformation, video/photo archive, marketing/social media, volunteer literacy and reading partners, Latinas with Purpose, and school-wide events and outreach.

<u>School of the Arts.</u> Musicians from the Music Program, Mr. Christopher Aguirre and Mr. Steven DeRosa, played a musical piece.

# PRESENTATION: END OF YEAR RECOGNITIONS-STUDENT PROGRAMS, LAS POSITAS COLLEGE

Dr. Barry Russell and Las Positas College Staff recognized outstanding programs and students for 2013-14, and acknowledged and celebrated those in attendance.

<u>Student Life:</u> Ms. Cynthia Ross, Student Life Director, presented a PowerPoint presentation highlighting the Las Positas College Student Life events and accomplishments of 2013-14. Ms. Ross expressed the importance of Student Life, which helps students feel connected and engaged; which translates into student success. She reported that Las Positas College is committed to providing programs and services that foster student participation in government activities, organizations and cultural events.

Ms. Ross recognized the achievements of the Athletics Programs:

Cross-Country: Coast Conference Championships - Men 2<sup>nd</sup>, Women, 4<sup>th</sup>.

Swim and Dive: Coast Conference Championships - Men 2<sup>nd</sup>, Women 4<sup>th</sup> and State Championships - LPC represented in 7 events.

Soccer: Men – 2013 North Coast Conference Champions; Women – Regional Playoffs Quarter Finals.

Ms. Ross recognized the Performing Arts Program "An American Nutcracker"; as well as students participation in the Music Association of California Community College Conference, San Francisco Youth Orchestra, and Best of the Best.

Ms. Ross recognized the following recipients of the Alpha Gamma Sigma Honor Society (AGS) Statewide Awards: Ed Walsh Service Award – Cherry Ronaele Bogue; Charles Bell Service Award – Amayr Sufi and Ameyalli Yerena; Virginia Coffey Academic Award – Monica Quinlan. Other Honors: AGS Student Trustee – Ameyalli Yerena.

Ms. Ross also recognized Ms. Jesse Bowens - 2014 All California Academic Second Team, naming her as one of the top 50 community college students in California; AGS Statewide Robert Mantovani Academic, Service and Leadership Award; and 2013-14 Livermore Chamber of Commerce/Sandia National Laboratory Las Positas College Student of the Year.

Ms. Ross recognized the many Student Clubs Events and Accomplishments, as well as the ASLPC sponsored Events for Fall 2013 and Spring 2014. She reported that ASLPC donated over \$8,000 to programs; Scholarships of almost \$30,000; Textbook Loaner Program servicing over 400 students; Textbook Assistant Scholarships; and donations of supplies. Ms. Ross also highlighted the Students' Advocacy/Capacity Building through the Fall Retreat, Advocacy Days, March-in-March (March 3, 2014), and National Center for Student Leadership Conference in Washington, DC.

<u>ESL Program.</u> Mr. Jonathan Brickman, ESL Program, presented a PowerPoint Presentation on the ESL Program highlights, and its students' challenges and accomplishments. He proudly reported that 100% of students that successfully complete the ESL Program are successful in English 1A.

<u>Biology:</u> Ms. Nan Ho, Instructor, presented a PowerPoint Presentation on Biology 1 (Cell and Molecular Biology) and its Cloning and Sequencing Project. Students Ms. Emmry Stimson, Ms. Anna Maria Hadjilambbris, Mr. Jason Maxwell, and Mr. Giavonni Jordan (Mentor Team) introduced themselves and shared their experiences of the project.

<u>Welding Program:</u> Mr. Scott Miner, Welding Instructor, presented a slide presentation highlighting several Welding Program achievements and community projects, including participating in the restoration of the beacon atop Mt. Diablo. Mr. Miner introduced Welding Students Ms. Heather Vangene, Ms. Kayla Shepodd, and Ms. Amber Nabors, who shared their projects and positive experiences as women welders in the program.

<u>Speech and Forensics Program:</u> Mr. James Dobson, Forensics Director, spoke of the Program's and students' successes (149 total awards and first place team award in Northern California; fourth place in the Country). In addition, he spoke to the students' community involvement. Student Ms. Erica Efigenio demonstrated her award winning speech.

#### **Board Comments:**

Trustee Dr. Cedillo expressed appreciation to the Colleges for this evening's presentations and "validating the work" that the Board does.

Trustee Mr. Gelles expressed his belief in the importance of community colleges. He expressed his enjoyment of this evening each year and the motivation he receives from the students. He acknowledged staff "for a job well done."

Trustee Dr. Mertes expressed appreciation to the students for their creative ideas and their many talents; and to the leadership of the Colleges.

Trustee Mr. Vecchiarelli expressed appreciation for all the presentations this evening, and especially commended the Biology students and instructor for their presentation.

Trustee Mrs. Dvorsky noted that she and her Board colleagues look forward to this evening each year. She noted she is amazed and stunned by all that is going on at the Colleges. She expressed appreciation to the Chancellor, College Presidents and Faculty.

Trustee Dr. Mitzman also expressed that this is his favorite time of year with award ceremonies, celebrations and commencement. He expressed that this is why he is a Trustee.

Trustee Dr. Gin expressed that this evening is "the best of the best in many ways" - at our Colleges and in our communities. He expressed appreciation to the faculty, students and the families of the students who support them. He expressed that he looks forward to commencement.
