In addition to the Scope of Work outlined in the original Subaward, Chabot College will also conduct the following:

Chabot College agrees to plan, coordinate and teach Early Childhood Development classes to (30) parents within the Hayward Unified School District (HUSD). W.K. Kellogg funding will cover the tuition costs for up to 30 parents taking six early childhood development college unit classes.

Key staff from Chabot College will do the following:

- Provide lecture instruction as Helen Turner State Preschool
- Provide hands on practice in HUSD State Preschool classrooms
- Offer morning and afternoon session Early Childhood Development 50 = 3 units, \$138.00
- Offer morning and afternoon session Early Childhood Development 96 = 1 unit, \$46.00
- Offer morning and afternoon session Early Childhood Development 95 = 1 unit, \$46.00
- Offer credit for attending the Early Childhood Conference on May 9, 2014 = 1 unit, \$46.00

Chabot College agrees to coordinate and provide parent education at Helen Turner State Preschool.

W.K. Kellogg funding will cover tuition costs for up to 30 parents.

- Tuition is \$46.00 per unit plus a \$3.00 mailing fee. Students will be able to take up to 6 units = \$279 x 30 parents = \$8,370.00.

Execution and coordination of the classes will commence in spring semester April 2, 2014 and run until June 26, 2014. Data should be reported upon the completion of the semester.

With the additional funding of \$8,370, brings the total Subaward amount to \$28,670 (\$8,370 Additional + \$20,300 Original).
