### Student Success and Support Program

#### November 2014



#### Introduction

Las Positas College has developed a strong plan to focus attention on Student Success and Support. While this plan is only a small portion of the student success activities across the campus, it does provide a focus for students who are new to the campus and most likely, new to community college and higher education. The Student Success and Support Program is seen as the first of many interventions to support student success.

#### Overview

The College strategy for implementing the Seymour-Campbell Student Success Act of 2012 (SB 1456), otherwise known as the Student Success and Support Program, was to target Spring 2014 continuing students who had not completed the mandated three (3) core services (orientation, assessment, and educational planning) for enrollment priority. In addition, all new and returning students who had applied for Summer and Fall 2014 were informed of the new requirements. The primary incentive was to impart to our students the importance of an earlier registration date based on Student Success and Support Program (SSSP) core services completion.

The key areas covered with the Student Success and Support Program are

- Orientation,
- Assessment/Placement,
- Counseling, Advising and Other Educational Planning Services
- Follow Up for At-Risk Students

Attached to this newsletter update, you will find examples of flyers that have been developed to help students better understand their responsibilities. The flyers have been used in print, online, and social media format so that we can better reach out to the students.

#### Program Focus

Las Positas College is beginning a new program to encourage better placement and better success into the math sequence. The program will allow students to enroll in a one week course before the semester begins. It will allow them to brush up on math skills and focus on skills that they may have once learned but have possibly forgotten or did not learn in depth enough to retain the information. See the attached flyer information. These students will be tracked throughout their LPC career so that it can be determined what effect Math Jam had on their success.
