History of Middle College

- Originated in NY, 1974, as an alternative to the traditional high school curriculum.
- This unique program combines the last two years of high school with the first two years of college and provides students with counseling, small classes, and an interdisciplinary curriculum.
- In California, students receive dual credit for both high school and college.

Middle College at Las Positas College

• This is the only program of this kind in the state of California.



Implementation

Spring 2015:

- 132 initial applicants
- 34 sophomore students successfully completed applications/eligibility process
- Interviewed all 34 applicants, provided additional information about the program, and answered any questions for parents and students.
- Develop Student Educational Plans for each student
- LPC Course Registration
