Early Decision Program

- Visits by Counselors and Assessment Staff to 26 area schools to outreach and matriculate students through Student Success and Support Program (SSSP)
- Development of Initial Student Ed. Plan (SEP)
- Success Indicators:
 - Success in English 1A (2x as likely after 2 & 4yrs)
 - Higher persistence; Transfer- Directed (2x)
 Degrees (2x) Transfer Ready (2-3x)

Veteran Students Success

- Fall 2013 382 Veteran Students (20% women, 80% men)
 - 41% full-time/59% part-time
 - 46% are 25-39 years of age
- Veteran's Resource Center Opening Fall 2015
- New Student Veterans Psychology-Counseling Class Fall 2015
- Counseling and tutoring
- Mentoring and VA support with American Legion


Non-Resident Students

- Fall 2014 Enrollments at Census:
 - 57 New High School Students from other States
 (3%) & I I 0 from other Countries (5%)
 - 179 Unknown (8%)
 - Out of 2,199 total New High School Students
 - 251 (10%) Transfer Students from other colleges out of state & 138 (5%) Transfer Students from other Colleges out of Country
 - Unknown 168 (7%)
 - Out of 2,523 total Transfer Students from other Colleges


International Students

- 54 F-1 Visa Students (38 men/16 women) from 17 countries.
- Top 5 countries are in this order: China,
 Vietnam, Canada, Finland, and Hong Kong.
- The top 3 majors are Business, Liberal Arts & Computer Science
- 50 full time, 4 OPT post completion of studies internships/employment
