Subject: Approval to Renew Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) – Safety Center, Incorporated, District – Economic Development: OSHA Training Center

<u>Background</u>: Safety Center, Inc. is an organization founded in 1934, whose mission is to reduce injuries and save lives by providing safety education and training. They accomplish this mission by promoting lifelong safety and health through a variety of community and professional programs.

Safety Center, Inc. and the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District's OSHA Training Center created a Memorandum of Understanding to serve the training needs of those who are located in the Sacramento Valley and adjacent communities, effective July 2010. The Memorandum of Understanding is deemed to be effective and shall remain in effect for each successive year unless otherwise terminated.

The OSHA Training Center currently has 31 classes scheduled at the Safety Center in Sacramento, for the calendar year 2015. Expenses and revenue for the classes will be shared by both parties.

The Board of Trustees approved the original Memorandum of Understanding on July 20, 2010, under item 7.5, and June 17, 2014 under item 6.9.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed renewal of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Safety Center, Incorporated and District – Economic Development, for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. It is further recommended that the Board authorizes the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the MOU on behalf of the District.
