


Emergency Preparedness Assessment Report

Board of Trustees Meeting, February 16, 2016





- Summer 2015, the Senior Leadership Team (SLT)
 discussed and determined that a comprehensive
 approach to addressing safety and security district-wide
 was needed
- The Chancellor assigned (former) Vice-Chancellor Esposito-Noy the responsibility of coordinating this effort to assess current conditions and provide recommendations in order to determine needs districtwide
- Information collected from Colleges including Campus Safety
- Long-Term Goal: to be as prepared as conceivably possible



WHAT ARE WE DOING NOW?





- Colleges have made significant efforts to provide faculty and staff with emergency procedures and preparedness documents
- Emergency Preparedness Handbook and Emergency Procedures posted in all college buildings. Documents updated in summer/fall 2015, shared with the management teams, and training has occurred on campuses
- Established next steps for Emergency Response Efforts
 - Assess, Prioritize, and Implement action items in the following year





- 1. Assess physical security and safety at all sites
- 2. Review current alert / warning system district-wide, for possible upgrade
- Review and Create a UNIFIED Emergency Action Plan district-wide
- 4. Provide facility and staff training for Emergency Action Plan procedures
- 5. Additional training/projects include:
 - Implementation of annual ICS and SEMS/NIMS Training
 - Provide recommendations on emergency logistics/equipment/supplies
