## YOUR PROGRAM INCLUDES

- Housing in shared rooms in a student residence.
- Travel pass for use on the buses and underground trains in zones 1 and 2.
- Orientation program on-site in London including an orientation meeting with AIFS staff, information packet, welcome dinner and guided half-day sightseeing tour of London by private bus.
- Tickets to five theater performances, including one at Shakespeare's Globe.
- Tours of the Globe Theatre and BBC Broadcasting House.
- Backstage tours of the National Theatre (or similar) and Royal Drury Lane Theatre.
- Walking tour of London's theatre district.
- Workshop at a London theatre.
- Full-day excursion to Stratford-upon-Avon including guided walking tour, entrance to Shakespeare's Birthplace, a half-day performance workshop and a ticket to a performance by the Royal Shakespeare Company.
- Access to the wireless-enabled AIFS Student Center and the services of the AIFS Program Coordinator and Student Advisors for information, personal advising/counseling and 24-hour emergency contact service.

- Use of the AIFS student computer lab with free printer and Internet access.
- Medical and Program Free Refund Insurance policy.
- \$50 non-refundable application fee.

## FEES

Based on an enrollment of 10-14 participants, the fee per person is \$3,465.

This fee excludes airfare, a \$125 refundable damage deposit, optional insurance upgrades, passport or visa fees if applicable, meals other than those listed, personal expenses, any LPC tuition or administrative fees, textbooks, additional field trips or excursions required by the LPC faculty and anything not specified.

These fees are guaranteed not to change as a result of fluctuations in the \$ exchange rate.

## OPTIONAL TRANSPORTATION PACKAGE

An optional Transportation Package is available, consisting of round-trip airfare between San Francisco and London and round-trip transfers overseas between the airport and housing for an additional \$815. Mandatory additional U.S. government- and airline-imposed departure taxes, fees and fuel surcharges of \$765 (subject to change) will be billed separately.
