1. This amendment (the "Amendment") is made by **SAN JOSE EVERGREEN COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT; WORKFORCE INSTITUTE ("SJECCD-WORKFORCE INSTITUTE")** and **LAS POSITAS COLLEGE ("PARTNER")** parties to the **CAREER PATHWAY TRUST, ROUND 2 PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT** dated **JULY 1, 2015** (the "Agreement").
