**Subject:** Student Health, Parking Services & Transportation Services Fees

Education Code sections 76355, 76360, and 76361 provide the governing board of a community college district the option of increasing health, parking services, and transportation services fees by the same percentage as the increase in the Implicit Price Deflator for State and Local Government Purchases of Goods and Services as published by the U.S. Department of Commerce.

If the percentage increase calculation produces an increase of one dollar above the existing fee, the fee may be increased by \$1.00.

Based on national Implicit Price Deflator fiscal year average calculations by the California Department of Finance<sup>1</sup>, the Implicit Price Deflator Index increased enough from last year to produce an increase in transportation services semester fees. Other fees remain unchanged as shown in the table below.
