Subject: Approval of Amendment No. 1 to the Child Development Training Consortium

(CDTC) 2019-2020 Instructional Agreement No. 19-20-2620 with Yosemite Community College District (YCCD/CDTC) and Chabot-Las Positas Community

College District, Las Positas College

<u>Background</u>: The Chabot-Las Positas Community College District, Las Positas College received a program renewal for the Child Development Training Consortium (CDTC) 2019-2020 Instructional Agreement No. 19-20-2620 in November 2019 with the Yosemite Community College District. The initial agreement allowed the College to generate up to 600 units of college credit by enrolling students in courses required by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing to obtain a new or renew a currently held Child Development Permit. As these courses do not generate state apportionment, the agreement provides the College with \$26 per enrolled unit of coursework, not to exceed a total of \$15,600.

The amended Agreement No. 1 allows the College to generate up to 823 units of college credit by enrolling students in courses required by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing to obtain a new or renew a currently held Child Development Permit. As these courses do not generate state apportionment, the agreement provides the College with \$26 per enrolled unit of coursework, not to exceed a total of \$21,398.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: That the Board of Trustees approves Amendment No. 1 to the Child Development Training Consortium (CDTC) 2019-2020 Instructional Agreement No. 19-20-2620 with Yosemite Community College District (YCCD/CDTC) and Chabot-Las Positas Community College District, Las Positas College. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor of Business Services, to execute this agreement on behalf of the District.
