## AP 4010 ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The academic calendar includes:

- The number of days that define an academic year (175 days of instruction and evaluation including Fflexible Calendar days)
- Holidays, which include:
- Labor Day (1st Monday in September)
- Veterans Day (November $11^{\text {th }}$ or options noted in Ed. Code reference)
- Thanksgiving (Wednesday and $4^{\text {th }}$ Thursday in November), and Friday after (Ref. FA Contract Article 8E.1)
- Christmas Day (December 25 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ )
- New Year's Day (January $1^{\text {st }}$ )
- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (3 ${ }^{\text {rd }}$ Monday in January)
- President's Days (Lincoln Day and Washington) (February $12^{\text {th }}$ or options noted in Ed. Code reference)
- Washington Day (3 ${ }^{\text {rd }}$ Monday in February)
- Memorial Day (Last Monday in May)
- Independence Day (July $4^{\text {th }}$ )

Other Holidays
Wednesday and Friday, before and after Thanksgiving, Ref. FA Contract Article 8E. 1
The Board of Trustees may declare other days to be holidays and close the colleges and offices when good reason exists.
