Subject: Acceptance of Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Hayward (COH) and the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District – Chabot College – for Emergency Food Distribution

<u>Background</u>: Since April 30, 2020, the City and Chabot College have partnered with the Hayward Area Reaction District (HARD) and Alameda County Community Food Bank (ACCFB) to host a weekly Drive-thru/No Contact Food Distribution site to support community members during the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting economic contraction.

Beginning August 6, 2020, the City needed to secure a new food distribution site. At this time, the College agreed to allow certain areas its campus to be temporarily used for a pilot food distribution effort. Recognizing the mutual benefit of continuing the food distribution while the pandemic continues to impact the community and the City's Emergency Operations Center continues to be activated, the District has agreed to continue to partner with the City to operate the food distribution and certain areas on the College campus to be used once a week for this purpose.

This agreement will remain active during the period of August 6, 2020 through June 30, 2021 and will terminate if the City's Emergency Operations Center deactivates sooner.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: That the Board of Trustees accept the Agreement for the period of August 6, 2020 through June 30, 2021. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Chancellor to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.
