Subject: Approval for Establishing Non-Resident (Out-of-State and International) Tuition

Rates for 2021-2022

<u>Background</u>: In accordance with Education Code Section 76140, the Board of Trustees must set the non-resident tuition rate for the succeeding fiscal year. In establishing this amount, the District may select from one of the following seven options:

- 1. District average cost (\$313)
- 2. District average cost with 10% or more non-credit FTES (N/A)
- 3. Statewide average cost (\$307)
- 4. Highest statewide average cost (\$307)
- 5. Contiguous District (Yosemite:\$307, Peralta:\$307, Contra Costa:\$307, Ohlone:\$294, Others:N/A)
- 6. Between statewide average expense of education and District expense of education (\$307-\$313)
- 7. Comparable states average (\$365)

The District served 424 full-time equivalent non-resident students in 2019-20 and 373 in 2018-19. The non-resident tuition rate of \$288 per semester unit was charged for the 2020-21 academic year along with a \$2 capital outlay fee for a total rate of \$290 per semester unit. Administration recommends the rate of \$313 per semester unit for the 2021-22 academic year plus a \$2 per unit capital outlay fee for a total of \$315 per semester unit.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: That the Board of Trustees approve the proposed non-resident tuition rate of \$315 per semester unit for the 2021-22 academic year for non-resident students and international students.
