- Q. Where can I find information about Bid No. B21/22-01 Districtwide Security Management Systems Refresh Project?

# Q. What is the scope for this project?

A. The Chabot Las Positas Community College District Security Management System Refresh Project is a technology refresh of existing security systems and devices.

The project includes two complete and independent Security Management Systems, including access control, video surveillance, and license plate recognition sub-system. One system will be installed and configured at Chabot College, in Hayward California and will control all related and subordinated systems and devices at the campus. The other system will be installed and configured at Las Positas College, in Livermore California and will control all related and subordinated systems and devices at the campus as well as those at the District Office, in Pleasanton California.

The project includes: new access control system, video surveillance system, and license plate recognition system servers and software; the replacement of the existing low frequency access control cards and fobs with new high frequency smart credentials and fobs; replacement of the existing access control system intelligent field panels, door controllers, I/O modules, and card readers with open architecture encrypted devices; replacement of the existing video surveillance system cameras and the installation of new cameras to existing emergency communication systems devices in the new Security Management System. Existing power supplies, field devices, electronic locking hardware, and wire and cabling will be utilized to the greatest extent possible, however new Ethernet cabling and powered fiber transceivers will be required to support communication to new IP cameras in various locations. The project will include set-up, configuration, and programming of the Security Management Systems at each campus.

### Q. What is the Engineering Estimate for this project?

A. The estimate for the District-Wide Security Management System Refresh Project is \$3,300,000.

### Q. What does the bid document consist of?

A. The bid document consists of District's Div. 00 and 01; Catalyst's technical specifications, drawings for the Chabot College campus, drawings for Las Positas College campus and the District Office.

Bidders MUST attend a job walk for each campus job walk. Sign in at Chabot will be required. Once completed at LPC, the attendees will receive the signed Site Certification form.

Bidders will meet at **10:00 a.m.** at the Chabot College Campus, 25555 Hesperian Blvd, Facilities Management Office Trailer, adjacent to Building 3000, Hayward, California 94545 and will then meet at 11:30 a.m. at Las Positas College Campus, 3000 Campus Hill Drive, Facilities Management Office Trailer, adjacent to Building 1300, Livermore, California 94551. Bidders MUST attend ENTIRE/BOTH campuses site walks to be eligible to participate in the bid.
