This Addendum 04 (Four) is issued to incorporate the following changes, additions or deletions to the RFP (B21/22-03). Any modifications/changes made by this addendum affect only the portions or paragraphs specifically identified herein; all remaining portions of the RFP (B21/22-03) to remain in force. It is the responsibility of all responders to conform to this addendum.

A. ADDITIONS, CHANGES AND/OR CLARIFICATIONS:

Requests for Information (RFI) and Responses:

Question 1: #13 - second bullet of the RFP response, please give

more details about what warranty information you are

referring to?

We haven't received this question before on a LLB RFQ/P and need more specific details to respond

appropriately.

Response: Lease-Leaseback Agreement, Article 6. Term and

Termination: requires the following staffing be present during the 12 month lease term, "During the final twelve months, the Contractor shall provide a skilled and trained staff member to assist the District with the startup, warranty period, and training of faculty, staff and administrators for a minimum of 8 hours per week. The skilled and trained staff member shall be approved by the District in advance and shall check in daily while on site with the District Project Manager and/or Maintenance Supervisor and assist



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as necessary in the installation of owner furnished items, correction of warranty issues, scheduling of training or training of staff members on the operation and control of building systems. Payment for services shall be included in the Financed Amount to Contractor on the terms set forth in the Facilities Lease." This period is also called out as the warranty period and the costs associated with this work shall be itemized in the proposal and GMP documents.

Question 2: #13 of the RFP response, please verify that we are to

establish our fee percentages based on a total project cost of \$34,478,000 as shown on Exhibit A1 of the

RFP.

Response: Correct

Question 3: Although our General Conditions costs will be

included in our proposed project fee %, do you

require a copy of our General Conditions spreadsheet

for the project with the RFP response?

Response: A general conditions spreadsheet is not required,

Exhibit E provides a matrix for the application of costs for reference, if the proposal deviates from the matrix

please identify.

Question 4: The insurance requirements provided in Exhibit C to

the Lease-Leaseback Agreement state that

earthquake and flood are required coverages under the Builders Risk. Please confirm that earthquake and flood are required and that this isn't just

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boilerplate language.

If earthquake and flood are required please let us know if the Public Contract Code 7105 applies.

Response: Per the General Conditions, including coverage for

earthquake and flood, as well as other coverage inclusions, are required as part of the Builder's Risk insurance, NOT as separate insurance policies.



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Question 5: We request that builder's risk and earthquake/flood

insurance costs (if required) be allowed to be provided as a separate \$ amount on the proposal, rather than as part of the proposal fee %. We believe that this is a more accurate way to capture the true

costs of builder's risk insurance.

Response: OK, this is allowed to be listed as a separate line item

of the proposal fee.

Question 6: Additionally, we request that we be allowed to requote

Builders Risk and Earthquake/flood (if they are required) at time of final GMP so that accurate costs are captured at that future date. The insurance market is fluctuating wildly and may increase or decrease by the time the final GMP is being

developed.

Response: Requoting the Builder's Risk insurance for the final

GMP is acceptable.

All other terms and conditions remain unchanged.
