The 1.0% reduction for Academic Year 2011-12 is to be expressed as a 2% reduction in payments from the basic salary schedule, January 1 through June 30, 2012, as follows:

- For Contract, Regular and Temporary Faculty (PART A), regular payments of salaries for January 2012 through June 2012, based on the amounts shown in this document, shall be multiplied by a deficit coefficient of 0.9899 to effect the 2% reduction for that period.
- For compensation in accordance with PART B, PART C, and PART D, effective rates for January 2012 through June 2012, as well as for Academic Year 2012-13, are provided in this document.

Degrees earned in universities outside the United States may be considered for this classification if such degrees are found by a competent authority recognized by the University of California (or the State Department of Education) to be equivalent to the Doctorate earned in the United States.)
