

As you know, the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District has temporarily suspended in-person classes for both Las Positas College and Chabot College on Thursday, March 12; Friday, March 13; and Saturday, March 14, 2020. Regularly scheduled online classes will continue without disruption.

The campus is not closing at this time and remains fully operational While we have zero reported cases among students or employees, we are taking this step in the interest of safeguarding the health and well-being of our students and employees.

For Thursday, March 12, Friday, March 13, and Saturday, March 14:

- In-person classes have been temporarily suspended. Regularly scheduled online classes will continue without disruption
- All college functions will remain open during regular business hours and out of class activities will continue as planned

For Monday, March 16 and beyond:

- Classes will resume on Monday, March 16, 2020 using either online education or limited in-person participation classes; you will receive notification directly from your instructors or the dean on how to proceed with your coursework.
- All college services and departments will remain open during regular business hours.
- Access to <u>computer labs</u> are available within Building 800 and Building 2000 (Library) during business hours. Students who are enrolled in classes that take place outside of business hours are encouraged to contact their instructors or the Dean's Office for assistance.
- Students can learn how to use the college's online learning platform, Canvas, by visiting the <u>Canvas webpage</u>.
- Counselors are available to meet with students in-person and online.
 Counselors may help with academic, career, and personal matters. To schedule a counseling appointment, please call (925) 424-1400 or visit the Counseling Department webpage.
- The <u>Student Health & Wellness Center</u> will remain open. Health care assistance and mental health services will continue to be provided to students on an individual basis and group settings by means of workshops.
- Tutorial services will remain open. Students may also access free, <u>online</u> <u>tutorial services</u> through Canvas.
