<u>Background</u>: Chabot and Las Positas Colleges have received notification from the Alameda County Social Services Agency, Children and Family Services of its intent to renew continuation of services for the Parent Resources for Information, Development and Education (PRIDE) Training Program.

The Colleges will offer childcare, food and related supplies/miscellaneous items to the participants of the pre-service PRIDE Training classes while they are attending these classes. The classes inform and prepare potential foster and adoptive parents in making successful, permanent connections with foster youth. The classes are open to kinship families, respite providers and the general public who are interested in understanding the needs of children in out-of-home care, and are under the protection of the Department's Foster Care System.

The Alameda County Social Service Agency will recommend for approval to the Alameda County Board of Supervisors, the preliminary grant renewal amount of \$42,865 for the period of July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

Approval of Contract Award Renewal— Alameda County Social Services Agency

Community Action to Reach Out to Infants (CARI) Program, Chabot College

<u>Background</u>: Chabot College has received notification from the Alameda County Social Services Agency of its intent to renew a grant for the continuation of services for the Community Action to Reach Out to Infants (CARI) Program.

Under the CARI Program, the College provides specialized, pre-designed training for potential Foster Parents, Kinship Caregivers and Respite Providers to care for children that enter Alameda County's Child Protective Services through drug exposure, HIV, neglect or abuse. This will be the seventh year the Alameda County Board of Supervisors has chosen to reconfirm its dedication to the ideals of service to the community through the maintenance of this partnership with the College.

The Alameda County Social Service Agency will recommend for approval, to the Alameda County Board of Supervisors, the preliminary grant renewal amount of \$38,579 for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.

The Board of Trustees approved grant renewals on August 19, 2003 under item 4.2 for \$60,000, July 20, 2004 under item 4.2 for \$36,000, July 19, 2005 under item 4.4 for \$36,000, June 27, 2006 under item 4.3 for \$36,000, August 21, 2007 under item 4.2 for \$36,000, June 24, 2008 under item 4.3, June 23, 2009 under item 4.1 for \$36,000 and July 20, 2010 under item 4.1 for \$36,000, June 28, 2011 under item 4.4 for 36,000, June 26, 2012 under item 4.4 for \$36,000, June 25, 2013 under item 5.10 for \$36,720, July 15, 2014 under item 4.10 for \$37,454.40.
