PRESENTATION: CARNEGIE GRANT (CHABOT COLLEGE)

Ms. Marcia Corcoran, Mr. Tom deWit and Ms. Katie Hern gave a PowerPoint Presentation on the initial findings and analysis from the first semester of Springboard to Transfer, a program funded through a joint grant from the Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching and the William and Flora Hewlett Foundation. The program is a threesemester learning community designed to prepare students for transfer. The second portion of the grant is a Faculty Inquiry Project—"Talking about Teaching."

PRESENTATION: CAMPUS CHANGE NETWORK: BUILDING CULTURAL AWARENESS, OUTREACH AND STUDENT SUCCESS (LAS POSITAS COLLEGE)

Ms. Pam Luster and Mr. Jeff Baker gave a PowerPoint Presentation on the Las Positas College program strengthening access and equity efforts through a peer lead learning effort called the Campus Change Network (CCN). The network consists of seven community colleges and is sponsored by California Tomorrow.

Ms. Luster introduced Ms. Ireri Valenzuela-Vergara, Senior Associate, California Tomorrow, who spoke briefly about the work of California Tomorrow. Ms. Vergara responded to questions asked by the Board.

Las Positas College's CCN efforts include:

- Building Cultural Awareness
- Outreach and Recruitment
 - For Students Faculty, Staff and Administrators
- Basic Skills Student Success
 - Building the success rate for transferable coursework completion

Ms. Jennifer Adams, a member of the LPC Team, described what the program means to her.

The Board voiced that they would like to see Chabot College apply for involvement in the network next year. Mrs. Dvorsky expressed interest in hearing more next year as the program progresses.
