About the Plans

- Three separate, but interconnected documents
- Use of “Initiatives” puts projects into a broader context
- Initiatives support organizational goals and priorities
- Plans are working documents with annual updates



The Initiatives

- Groupings of projects with similar purposes
- Initiatives are the same across all three plans
- Projects will come and go, but initiatives persist
- Each initiative specifically recognizes Diversity, Equity, Inclusion and Accessibility
- Initiatives align thematically with administrators' roles



Initiative #1

Maintain a Current Technical Environment – Ensure that students, faculty, and staff have access to sufficient and properly configured computing resources, effective online resources, and a highly available and secure network in support of, diversity, equity, inclusion, accessibility, teaching, student support and administrative services.



Initiative #2

Improve the Student Experience – Provide students with easily accessible tools that enable them to effectively use online student services such as advising appointments, course registration, and tracking degree progress to promote diversity, equity, inclusion and accessibility.



Initiative #3

Advance Teaching and Learning – Use technology to enable the District to continually enhance a diverse, equitable, inclusive and accessible student learning environment by supporting faculty in their efforts to integrate innovative pedagogical methods to address a wide array of learning styles.



Initiative #4

Improve Operational Efficiency – On a continuous basis, evaluate and improve technology planning and decision-making processes, enhance training for faculty and staff, and use technology that supports diversity, equity, inclusion and accessibility to reduce the reliance on paper and automate manual tasks.



Initiative #5

Continually Enhance Data Security – Evaluate the College’s security posture on a continuous basis, work to mitigate vulnerabilities and reduce security risks, and promote security awareness among students, faculty, and staff through ongoing training that minimizes potential harm in our diverse, equitable, inclusive and accessible community.
