<sup>2</sup>Should either college not be on pace to achieve their 2025-26 FTES target, remaining allocation will be reduced for Spring 2026 as outlined below. "On pace" means achieving or exceeding the Fall 2024 credit and noncredit combined FTES (Full-Time Equivalent Students) as of the same point in time, after census, and no later than September 30, 2025. The actual credit and noncredit combined FTES numbers for Fall 2025, as of September 29, 2025, will be compared to the DEMC dashboard report for credit and noncredit combined FTES from the corresponding week in Fall 2024 (specifically, September 30, 2024). If, by the end of September 2025, actuals are not "on-pace" with the approved targets, designated FTEF reductions will be made for the Spring 2026 schedules (13.40 for Chabot College and 3.0 for LPC), per the recommendation.
