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
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
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#### 2021 Educational Master Plan Development Process



- Activities recognizable actions or projects

## Strategic Plan Goal: Updated 2019

We will provide student-ready college services and academic programs to improve educational equity and to increase the number of students who reach progress milestones and identify and achieve their educational goals.



- <u>Equity</u> for Black and disproportionately impacted students and employees
- <u>Access</u>: Removing barriers from application through enrollment and expanding opportunities for a strong start
- <u>Pedagogy and Praxis</u>: Engaging teaching and learning for developing content knowledge, critical thinking, and skill development
- Holistic and integrated support for student <u>Success</u>
- <u>Community and Partnerships</u>: Relationships that support the needs and goals of the college community

## Objectives

#### **EQUITY**

- Provide supportive onboarding experiences based on student interest, need, and goal.

## Objectives

#### **PEDAGOGY AND PRACTICE**

- Develop and embed culturally relevant, revitalizing, and sustaining pedagogy across the curriculum.
- Expand opportunities for experiential learning through internships, externships, community-based and project-based learning.

#### **SUCCESS**

- Reduce barriers to academic and non-academic support services.
- Increase program completions and transfers

#### **COMMUNITY AND PARTNERSHIPS**

- Leverage internal and external stakeholders to enhance programs, opportunities, and support for students, faculty, and staff.
- Expand opportunities for Chabot to connect to the external community.
