We have not been able to implement this project on top of the COVID-19 impacts to A&R work focusing overtime worked on XW manual refunds, manually re-setting PIN's, and high volume of emails and phone calls associated with registration. Additionally, the department has several vacancies inhibiting new projects.

A&R is considering a couple designated Saturdays in early spring to work on Residency Re-classifications, keeping in mind overtime cannot be mandated and most A&R staff are already putting in over-time related to the pandemic and several position vacancies.

We reviewed our Residency Determination AP's and see we are farther out of compliance with our procedures than initially realized. With nearly 600 AB540 petitions per year, and a myriad of other externally-driven impacts on A&R happening simultaneously outlined below, a more comprehensive approach will be needed beyond this \$5000 overtime allocation for residency re-classification petitions.
