Chabot College and Las Positas College are fully accredited by the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges, Western Association of Schools and Colleges (ACCJC), an institutional accrediting body recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation and the U.S. Department of Education. Links to accreditation status must be published on each college's website accessible to the public.

The colleges are accredited every seven years. Throughout the seven-year review cycle, the colleges conduct and publish review instruments that include: annual reports; annual fiscal reports; mid-term reports, and institutional self-evaluation reports in accordance with the ACCJC Accreditation Standards.

The district-wide Accreditation Coordinating Committee is responsible for coordinating district-wide accreditation readiness and meets periodically to coordinate progress towards accreditation standards. Members of the committee include personnel from both the district office and the colleges, including the college's Accreditation Liaison Officer. The committee is chaired by the vice chancellor of educational services and student success.
