- Labor Day ( $1^{\text {st }}$ Monday in September)
- Veterans Day (November 11 $1^{\text {th }}$ or options noted in Ed. Code reference)
- Thanksgiving ( $4^{\text {th }}$ Thursday in November)
- Christmas Day (December $25^{\text {th }}$ )
- New Year's Day (January $1^{\text {st }}$ )
- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (3 ${ }^{\text {rd }}$ Monday in January)
- Lincoln Day (February 12 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ or options noted in Ed. Code reference)
- Washington Day (3 ${ }^{\text {rd }}$ Monday in February)
- Memorial Day (Last Monday in May)
- Juneteenth (June $19^{\text {th }}$ or options noted in Ed. Code reference)
- Independence Day (July 4 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ )

Other Holidays:
Wednesday and Friday, before and after Thanksgiving, Ref. FA Contract Article 8E. 1
The Board of Trustees may declare other days to be holidays and close the colleges and offices when good reason exists.
