## **BP 5035** WITHHOLDING OF STUDENT RECORDS

## Reference:

Title 5 Section 59410

Students or former students who have received official notification (college-assigned email address or via U.S. mail) that they have failed to pay a proper financial obligation shall have diplomas and registration privileges withheld.

Whenever a student is delinquent through failure to comply with college procedures, to pay debts, or to return property owned by the college, the student's records will be placed on hold. A student whose records are placed on hold shall not be allowed to:

- 1. register for subsequent terms of instruction or
- 2. receive other services in the college which relate to their records.

When the student has cleared their obligation with the college, the hold/s placed shall be removed.
