SUBJECT: CLPCCD Mask Mandate Update

The Chabot-Las Positas Community College District had been scheduled to transition away from the mask mandate at the end of the day today. The mandate has been in place as a safety measure to limit the transmission of COVID-19. Yesterday, Alameda County health officials announced that masks will again be required in most indoor public settings beginning 12:01 a.m. on Friday, June 3, 2022. This means that until further notice from public health officials, masks will continue to be required indoors at all district facilities.

The new order from Alameda County health officials comes as our county sees high levels of daily reported COVID-19 cases. Wearing a high-quality mask protects you and those around you while we navigate this time of high community transmission levels. We will continue to monitor our county's situation and will keep you apprised of any changes. Please find the attached full press release from the Alameda County Public Health Department.
